





AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5.08, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES", SECTION 5.08.080, LICENSES - CLASSES AND FEES", OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.080, "Licenses - Classes and Fees", of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by adding Subsection "P" thereto as follows:

"P. Class P licenses shall authorize the retail sale of wine in packages and not for consumption on the premises. The holder of such a license may only sell wine as part of a gourmet food/gift basket and not separately. Such license shall be issued only to a retail store open to the general public. Each such licensee shall obtain the proper license from the Illinois Liquor Control Commission. Such license shall permit the sale of wine only during the period from November 1 until December 31. The fee for such license shall be \$300.00."

2. That Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.090, "License-Number to be Issued", be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

"5.08.090 License - Number to be issued.
There shall be issued not more than a maximum of seven (7) Class "A", twelve (12) Class "B", eleven (11) Class "C", one (1) Class "D", one (1) Class "E" three (3) Class "F", and permitted supplementary license for Class "D" licenses in any license year, four (4) Class "I", plus one license for each of the special restricted classes as set forth in this Chapter, twenty (20) Class "N" licenses, plus one (1) Class "O" license, plus one (1) Class "P" license."


2. Penalty. Any person, firm, or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.

3. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
