BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter
10.40, "Stopping, Standing and Parking", of the St. Charles
Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the
same and substituting the following therefore:

"10.40.045 Residential Parking Only.

It is unlawful at any time to cause, allow
or permit any vehicle to stop, stand or park in
any of the following places, except when necessary
to avoid conflict with other traffic or in
compliance with the direction of a police officer
or official traffic control device, or if such
vehicle is licensed to a resident whose residence
is located on property abutting the following
public right-of-way:

1. On both sides of Highgate
Course from the northerly right-of-
way of Fox Chase Boulevard.

2. The Superintendent of Streets and Sewers shall
cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is
prohibited, indicating such prohibition.

3. Any person who violates any of the provisions of
this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less
than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars
(\$500.00) for each offense and each day shall be considered
a separate offense.

That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof published in a newspaper in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
