BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 2.32, "Police Department", of the St.
Charles Municipal Code, be and the same is hereby amended by
deleting Sections 2.32.010, 2.32.030, Subparagraph A, and
2.32.070 and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

"2.32.010 Created -Composition.

There is created a police department, an
executive department of the city. The police
department shall consist of the chief of police,
two lieutenants, eight sergeants, one corporal,
twenty-five patrol officers, and such other
members that may be provided for from time to
time by the mayor and city council. All appointed
police officers of the police department, includ-
ing the chief of police, are to be considered
employees of the city.

2.32.030 Powers and duties of police chief and
department.

A. The chief of police shall perform the
duties that the city council prescribes
for the preservation of the public peace,
the observance and enforcement of
ordinances and laws and prevention and
detection of criminal activity. The
police shall be responsible for planning,
directing, coordinating, controlling and
staffing all activities of the department
for its continued and efficient operation,
for the enforcement of the rules and
regulations within the department, for the
completion and forwarding of such reports
as may be required by competent authority,
and for the department's relations with
the citizens of St. Charles, the city
government, and other official agencies."

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


