AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.08 "ELECTRICITY"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," Sections 13.08.140 "Deposit -
Required - Refund - Exemption," 13.08.190 "Right to cut-off for
nonpayment - Reconnection," of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and are
hereby amended by deleting 13.08.140A, 13.08.140B and 13.08.190B and
substituting the following therefore:

"13.08.140 Deposit - Required - Refund - Exemption

- A. The sum of one hundred dollars shall accompany the application,
as a deposit, for each new residential electrical user and the
sum of two hundred dollars for each new commercial or industrial
electrical user who is not an owner of real property in the
city. Further, an additional amount of deposit shall be charged
to any customer at any time if such customer meets any of the
following criteria:
1. the customer pays late four times during the prior
twelve month period, or
 2. the utility has disconnected service within the last
twelve month period for violation of the provisions of the
ordinance, or
 3. the utility finds out that the application for service was
falsified.

The additional deposit charged shall be in an amount equal to the
two highest monthly billings for the twelve month period ending
immediately prior to the request for the additional deposit; or
if a twelve month period is unavailable, then any portion
thereof, which amount shall be reduced by the amount of the
deposit on hand, whether \$100, \$200, or a lesser sum.

The deposits set forth above shall be repaid to such applicants
when the city has discontinued or refused the service for which
such applications were made and when all bills owing the city by
such applicants for such service have been paid in full. If any
such applicant has not paid all bills owing the city for such
service within thirty days after such service has been
discontinued, then the city clerk shall deduct the amount of the
bills so owing from such deposit and remit the balance, if any,
to such depositor.

- B. All deposits made by applicants as provided in subsection A of this section shall be refunded by the city clerk's office, after two years of continuous electrical service during which the customer does not pay late more than two times during the latest twelve month period and has received no disconnection notice during that same twelve month period. Deposits will be returned by crediting the customers utility bill for the amount of deposit.

"13.08.190 Right to cut-off for nonpayment - Reconnection

- B. A customer's service so discontinued shall be reconnected after the customer has made settlement for his bills in arrears at the city clerk's office, or has, to the city's satisfaction, complied with or performed such other conditions or obligations of this chapter which were in default, as the case may be. A minimum fee shall be charged equal to two times one and one-half the midpoint of the wage rate for a meter technician at the time of reconnection. In the event the city incurs expense for labor in excess of the average cost of reconnection, the city may charge that additional cost for disconnection and reconnection to the customer.

2. That Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by adding Section 13.08.135 "Application for Service," as follows:

"13.08.135 Application for Service

- A. An application for service shall be required of all commercial, industrial, and non-owner residential customers. The application shall include the following information:
1. Non-owner Residential - Name, service address, billing address, home phone, and driver's license number.
 2. Commercial/Industrial - Name of business, type of business organization, billing address, service address, phone number, owners and/or president, and manager.

3. This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, approval and publication in accordance with law but no sooner than service provided on or after April 20, 1987. Publication in pamphlet form is hereby authorized and directed.


