

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, as follows:


1. That a certain agreement entitled, "An Amendment to an Agreement
Between TRI-CITY AMBULANCE SERVICE AND PARAMEDIC SERVICES OF ILLINOIS,
INC." for period from May 1, 1987 through April 30, 1988, a copy of
which is attached, be and is hereby approved and the Mayor is authorized
to sign the same and the City Clerk directed to attest his signature
thereto.

be printed or published in book or pamphlet form by the authority of the
City Council.



AN AMENDMENT TO AN
AGREEMENT BETWEEN TRI-CITY AMBULANCE SERVICE BY AND
THROUGH THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES LEAD AGENCY FOR
THE MEMBERS THEREOF AND PARAMEDIC SERVICES OF ILLINOIS, INC.
FOR PERIOD FROM MAY 1, 1986 THROUGH APRIL 30, 1987
EXTENDING TO APRIL 30, 1988

This Agreement entered into on this 20th day of April, 1987,
by and between the CITY OF ST. CHARLES, Kane and DuPage Counties,
Illinois (hereinafter "ST. CHARLES"), Lead Agency for TRI-CITY
AMBULANCE SERVICE which comprises St. Charles, the CITY OF
GENEVA, Kane County, Illinois (hereinafter "GENEVA"), the CITY OF
BATAVIA, Kane and Dupage Counties, Illinois (hereinafter
"BATAVIA"), the FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ST.
CHARLES, Kane and DuPage Counties, Illinois, a fire protection
district (hereinafter "ST. CHARLES FIRE"), BATAVIA TOWNSHIP AND
COUNTRYSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, Kane and DuPage Counties,
Illinois, a fire protection district (hereinafter "BATAVIA
FIRE"), GENEVA TOWNSHIP, Kane County, Illinois, a township
(hereinafter "GENEVA TOWNSHIP"), all said cities, fire protection
districts and township being sometimes collectively referred to
as "TRI-CITY AMBULANCE SERVICE" or "TRI-CITY" and PARAMEDIC
SERVICES OF ILLINOIS, INC., an Illinois Corporation (hereinafter
"PSI");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, TRI-CITY wishes to engage PSI to furnish paramedics
on a twenty-four hour basis for the full term of this Agreement
from May 1, 1987 through April 30, 1988; and

WHEREAS, TRI-CITY has entered an Agreement covering a period from May 1, 1986 through April 30, 1987 and both TRI-CITY and PSI wish to extend the same on the same terms and conditions except for the provisions hereafter described;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements of the parties hereto, it is agreed as follows:

1. That the Agreement heretofore entered by the parties mentioned therein dated April 7, 1986 covering the period from May 1, 1986 through April 30, 1987 be and is hereby extended under the same terms and conditions except paragraphs 6, 9, and 11 thereof which shall read as follows:

" 6. Insurance. PSI shall provide and maintain during the full term of this Agreement, professional, comprehensive general liability and malpractice insurance in the minimum aggregate amount of ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$ 1,000,000.00) per occurrence and ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$ 1,000,000.00) aggregate; and Workmen's Compensation insurance to cover the entire statutory liability to pay such compensation. PSI shall provide TRI-CITY AMBULANCE SERVICE with Certificates of Insurance providing coverages for all of the insurance requirements set forth herein with a provision requiring the insurance companies notify TRI-CITY at least thirty (30) days prior to any modification, cancellation or change in any respect of the policy or policies of insurance required hereunder."

"9. Payment. PSI shall be paid the sum of Thirty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Three and 28/100 Dollars (\$ 37,703.28) on May 31, 1987 and a like amount of Thirty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Three and 28/100 Dollars (\$ 37,703.28) on the last day of each and every month thereafter, with a final payment of Thirty Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Three and 28/100 Dollars on April 30, 1988 for a total of Four Hundred Fifty Two Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Nine and 36/100 Dollars (\$ 452,439.36)."

"11. Renewal. TRI-CITY shall have the option of renewing the Agreement for a period from May 1, 1988 through April 30, 1989 upon thirty day written notice subject to budgeting prior to April 30, 1988 for a total sum of Four Hundred Seventy Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Six and 92/100 Dollars (\$ 470,536.92) to be paid in twelve equal monthly installments of Thirty Nine Thousand Two Hundred Eleven and 41/100 Dollars (\$ 39,211.41) to be paid on the last day of each month starting May 31, 1988. The foregoing renewal figures will be increased by the actual increases in health insurance costs and workman's compensation insurance costs when these two costs exceed the 1987 costs for these two items. PSI will absorb the first four percent of the increase over the 1987 costs and TRI-CITY will pay for the excess over four percent. At least thirty days prior to TRI-CITY's date for exercising the option, PSI will furnish TRI-CITY the actual cost increase for the ensuing year."




