BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter
10.40, "Stopping, Standing and Parking", of the St. Charles
Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by adding the
following thereto:

"10.40.045 Residential Parking Only.

It is unlawful at any time to cause, allow
or permit any vehicle to stop, stand or park in
any of the following places, except when necessary
to avoid conflict with other traffic or in
compliance with the direction of a police officer
or official traffic control device, or if such
vehicle is licensed to a resident whose residence
is located on property abutting the following
public right-of-way:

1. On the easterly side of Highgate
Course from the northerly right-of-
way of Fox Chase Boulevard along the
easterly leg thereof to a point wherein
the northerly property line of 26 Highgate
Course extended westerly abuts the right-
of way and on the westerly side of the
easterly leg of Highgate Course from the
centerline of that portion extended
northerly from Fox Chase Boulevard to the
northerly property line of 21 Highgate
course extended easterly to the right-of
way Highgate Course.
2. Along the westerly leg of Highgate Course
on the westerly side of the street to
Fox Chase Boulevard to a point on the
northerly property line of 69 Highgate
Course where it intersects with the right-
of way of Highgate Course and on the
northerly and easterly side of Highgate
Course from the centerline of that portion
of Highgate Course extended northerly from

Fox Chase Boulevard to a point on the northerly property line of 106 Highgate Course where it intersects with the right-of-way of Highgate Course."

2. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter 10.40, "Stopping, Standing and Parking", Section 10.40.055, "Compromise of Claim of Sections 10.40.040 and 10.40.050" be and is hereby amended by inserting in the title and in the first line thereof after "10.40.040" the following:
", 10.40.045".

3. The Superintendent of Streets and Sewers shall cause signs to be posted in all areas where parking is prohibited, indicating such prohibition.


4. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense and each day shall be considered a separate offense.

5. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof published in a newspaper in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
