



ORDINANCE NO. 1988-M-35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC",
CHAPTER 10.58, "TOWING SERVICES", SECTION 10.58.200,
"FEES", OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic", Chapter
10.58, "Towing Services", Section 10.58.200, "Fees", of the
St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by
deleting said Section 10.58.200, "Fees", and substituting
the following therefor:

"10.58.200 Fees

- A. Towing - The maximum fee which may be charged by any towing operator hereunder for removing a vehicle from the street in response to a police call shall be as follows:
1. For a tow of any passenger car, motorcycle, stake panel or dumptruck empty, up to and including one ton,
 - a. For calls initiated between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 p.m., \$45 per call.
 - b. For calls initiated between the hours of 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., \$55 per call.
 2. For the removal of trucks, trailers, semitrailer or house trailers, loaded or empty, in excess of one ton or not covered in Subsection 1 above is \$65 per call.
 3. For police snow tow removal, \$55 an hour per tow truck.
 4. A towing operator who responds to a call but who is required to delay commencing the tow for a period of 20 minutes or more, due to circumstances beyond his control shall be permitted to charge at the rate of \$25 per hour per tow truck for such waiting time up to a period of two (2) hours.

5. Police vehicles for the City of St. Charles will be towed at no charge to the City.
 6. A towing service who responds to a call requiring two trucks or more, or is the type of call requiring special handling, shall, in addition to the charge specified in Item 1, be permitted to charge at the rate of \$75 per hour, by 15-minute increments. Special handling shall include, but not be limited to the following situations:
 - a. Vehicle roll-over.
 - b. Vehicle impacted in a building or other structure.
 - c. Vehicle in river.
 - d. Vehicle off the roadway greater than a distance of 25 feet requiring the use of a power winch for retrieval.
 - e. Vehicles requires the utilization of "snatch blocks" or "chalk blocks" for towing.
- B. Storage Charges - storage charges for vehicles shall be as follows:
1. For vehicles stored less than twenty-four (24) hours, no charge.
 2. For storage of all vehicles, \$10 maximum per day.
 3. No towed vehicles shall be stored or parked on any city street or alleyway on or about the towing operator's garage or parking lot for longer than ninety (90) minutes.
- C. Revision of rate - Notice of hearing
1. The City Council of the City of St. Charles may, from time to time, amend, by ordinance after a public hearing, the schedule of maximum fees or rates which may be charged for towing and storage services.
 2. Prior to the City Council hearing, there shall be a publication, at least once, of notice of said hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the City, at least ten (10) days before the hearing date. In addition thereto the hearing shall be preceded by at least ten (10) days' notice of such hearing, given by letter from the

City Clerk to each firm then listed on the roster herein provided, said letter directed to the address contained in the application submitted hereunder. Failure to give such notice shall not invalidate such fees."

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
