**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE UNAUTHORIZED  
COLLECTION OF RECYCLABLE MATERIAL BY AMENDING  
CHAPTER 5.32 "REFUSE COLLECTORS" AND CHAPTER 8.24,  
"GARBAGE AND REFUSE", OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.  
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Chapter 8.24, "Garbage and Refuse", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by adding Section 8.24.095, "Unlawful Removal of Recyclable Material" and Section 8.24.096, "Unlawful Damage to City Recycling Containers", as follows:

**"8.24.095 Unlawful Removal of Recyclable Material.**

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, except a refuse collector contracting with the City, to remove any item of recyclable material including newspaper, aluminum or bimetal cans, glass bottles or plastic milk containers placed in or adjacent to City recycling containers.

**8.24.096 Unlawful Damage to City Recycling Containers.**

Except as authorized by the City Council, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to remove, from a residential premises at which it is located, or to damage any city recycling container."

2. That Chapter 5.32, "Refuse Collectors", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by adding Section 5.32.055, "Unlawful Removal of Recyclable Material", as follows:

**"5.32.055 Unlawful Removal of Recyclable Material.**

It shall be unlawful for any refuse collector, except as authorized by the City Council, to remove any item of recyclable material including newspaper, aluminum or bimetal cans, glass bottles or plastic milk containers placed in or adjacent to City recycling containers."

3. That Chapter 8.24, "Garbage and Refuse" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting Section 8.24.100 and inserting in place thereof the following:

**"8.24.100 Penalty for Violation of Chapter 8.24.**


The person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which the violation occurs or continues."

4. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (a) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the City Council, or (b) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
