**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.16, "WATER",
SECTION 13.16.150, "METERS - REQUIRED - RATES",
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Chapter 13.16, "Water", Section 13.16.150, "Meters - Required - Rates", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

"13.16.150 Meters - Required - Rates.

All premises using the city water supply must be equipped with an adequate water meter and backflow prevention device furnished by the city, but paid for by the consumer, at the following rates:


1. Five-eighth inch by three-quarter inch, one hundred eighty dollars;
2. Three-quarter inch, by three-quarter inch, two hundred ten dollars;
3. One inch, three hundred dollars;
4. One and one-half inch, eight hundred fifty-five dollars;
5. Two-inch compound, one thousand eight hundred dollars;
6. Three-inch compound, one thousand nine hundred fifty dollars;
7. Four-inch compound, two thousand six hundred sixty dollars;
8. Fees for meters not listed over one and one-half inch will be based upon the cost to the city installed plus fifteen percent.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.




which provided by its terms that it should be published in pamphlet form.


Re: Ordinance Amendment Concerning

Enclosed please find a revised Ordinance regarding Section 13.16.150 which provides for an increased fee to cover the water meter and backflow prevention device.
