AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 13, "PUBLIC UTILITIES"
CAPTER 13.08, "ELECTRICITY"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 13, "Public Utilities", Chapter 13.08, "Electricity", Sections 13.08.150, and 13.08.160, of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and are hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefore:

"13.08.150 Residential electrical distribution connection fees.

- A. There is established a new service electrical distribution connection fee of one thousand two hundred per unit requiring a 100 amp single phase service; twenty four hundred dollars for a unit requiring a 200 amp single phase service and four thousand eight hundred for a unit requiring a 400 amp single phase service. For upgrading existing residential service there is no charge to upgrade to 100 amp single phase service; The following is a chart of the common residential electrical distribution connection and upgrading fees:

- B. A "unit" is a single-family residence or each apartment in an apartment building or other multiple dwelling or each trailer space in a trailer park and is to be considered a residential area including sleeping and toilet facilities.
- C. Three phase service shall not be available to residential customers.

"13.08.160 Commercial and industrial electrical distribution connection fee

- A. It is unlawful to make any connection with the city electrical distribution system without having first obtained a permit therefore.
- B. A commercial and industrial distribution connection fee is hereby established which shall apply to hotels and motels.

C. A connection fee shall be paid prior to the installation of any new or additional electrical service entrance equipment at any commercial or industrial building or enterprise. Excepted herefrom shall be the replacement of old existing equipment with new equipment of exactly the same rated electrical capacity. The fee shall be determined on the basis of size, or maximum rated capacity of the electric service entrance panel as expressed in kilovoltamperes (kva) in accordance with the following schedule:

2. That Title 13, "Public Utilities", Chapter 13.08 "Electricity", of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by adding Section 13.08.310 as follows:


"13.08.310 Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall upon conviction be fined not less than one dollar nor more than five hundred dollars for each offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day that a violation occurs or continues."

3. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (a) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (b) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles. However the ordinance shall not be effective before May 1, 1990.
