ORDINANCE NO. 1991 - M - 39

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5, "BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS"  
CHAPTER 5.14 "AMUSEMENT GAME DEVICES" OF THE  
ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,  
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 5 "Business Licenses and Regulations" Chapter  
5.14 "Amusement Game Devices" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be  
and is hereby amended as follows:

A. That Section 5.14.045 (D) be and is hereby deleted  
and Subparagraph "E" be and is hereby re-lettered as  
"D".

B. That Section 5.14.100 "Rules of Operation-Designated"  
Subparagraph "A(1)" be and is hereby amended by  
adding the following thereto:

"In the case of an enclosed shopping center,  
such insulation shall not be required for the  
exterior walls."

C. That Section 5.14.100 "Rules of Operation-Designated"  
Subparagraph "A(2)" be and is hereby amended by  
deleting the same and substituting the following  
therefore:

"No amusement game device shall be used  
for purposes of gambling as defined and  
prohibited under the laws of the State of  
Illinois."

- D. That Section 5.14.100 "Rules of Operation-Designated" Subparagraph "A(3)" be and is hereby amended by changing "1500 square feet" to "2500 square feet".
- E. That Section 5.14.100 "Rules of Operation-Designated" Subparagraph "A(5)" be and is hereby amended by changing "eighteen (18) years" to "seventeen (17) years" in both places in which it appears.
- F. That Section 5.14.100 "Rules of Operation-Designated" Subparagraph "A(7)" be and is hereby amended by adding the following thereto:
- "This Subparagraph "A(7)" shall not apply to licensed premises in enclosed shopping centers."

After the adoption and approval hereof, this ordinance shall (a) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (b) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
