

ORDINANCE NO. 96-M-79

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.12 "SEWERS"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 13.12 "Sewers," Section 13.12.830 "Charges for Residential Users" Subsection A, Paragraph 2, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

2. Residential users in a building with more than one dwelling unit with a sewer connection but no city water meter for each dwelling unit shall be charged for four thousand gallons of usage per dwelling unit at the existing residential rate per one thousand gallons plus the existing demand charge per month, except that the sewer charge shall not be based on the water meter servicing such residential building.

2. That Chapter 13.12 "Sewers," Section 13.12.840 "User Charges for Metered Water Consumption and Nonresidential Use," Subsection A, Paragraph 3, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:


3. Non-residential Users in a building with more than one non-residential unit with sewer connections but no city water purchases shall be charged for four thousand gallons of usage at the existing non-residential rate per one thousand gallons plus the existing demand charge per month, except that the sewer charge shall not be based on the water meter servicing such non-residential building.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the city of St. Charles. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon approval.
