ORDINANCE NO. 1997-M- 38

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5, "LICENSES"
CHAPTER 5.08, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES",
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5, "Licenses" Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.080, "License - Classes and fees", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by adding Paragraphs "R" and "U" as follows:

- "R. Class R licenses shall authorize the retail sale of gourmet beer and wine for consumption on the premises and also in packages and not for consumption on the premises. Curb service or sale is prohibited. The annual license fee for such license shall be \$1,600.00. This license is not to be removed from the location at 22 North Fourth Street in the City without the approval of the City Council and the consent of the local liquor control commissioner.
- U. Class U licenses shall permit supplementary licenses which authorize the retail sale of beer for consumption on or off the premises where brewed on the premises of the holder of a Class B license, provided the sale and consumption of food predominates the sale and consumption of alcoholic liquors. Curb service or sale is prohibited. This license is not to be removed from the location at 112 North First Avenue in the City without the approval of the City Council and the consent of the local liquor control commissioner. The annual license fee for such Class U license shall be \$600.00."

2. That Title 5, "Licenses" Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.080 "Licenses - classes and fees" , Subsection I (3), of the St. Charles Municipal

Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

“1. 3. Number of Licenses. There will be only six class I licenses in any one year: license numbers one, three, five, six, seven and eight.”

3. That Title 5, “Licenses” Chapter 5.08, “Alcoholic Beverages”, Section 5.08.090, “License - Number to be issued”, of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

5.08.090 License - Number to be issued.

There shall be issued not more than a maximum of ten class A, twenty-three class B, nine class C, one class D, one class E, three class F, and permitted supplementary license for Class D licenses in any license year, one class G, one class H, six class I, plus twenty class N licenses, provided, not more than two such class N licenses shall be issued for any twenty-four hour period, plus no more than two class O for any twenty-four hour period, plus one class R license, plus three class S licenses, plus one class T license, plus one class U license.”


4. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles; provided, however, that this Ordinance shall not become effective before May 1, 1997.


