Ordinance No. 1999-M-2

**An Ordinance Amending Title 3, "Revenue and Finance,"  
Chapter 3.38, "Yard Waste User Fee,"  
of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE  
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 3, "Revenue and Finance," Chapter 3.38, "Yard Waste User Fee," Section 3.38.010, "User Fee," of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

**3.38.010 User Fee.**

A user fee is hereby imposed upon single family residences or any building that contains **six** or fewer dwelling units, whether they be occupied or not, in the amount of \$1.50 each month. Said monthly charge shall appear on all residential utility bills beginning July 1, 1998.

2. That Title 3, "Revenue and Finance," Chapter 3.38, "Yard Waste User Fee," Section 3.38.020, "Exemptions," of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

**3.38.020 Exemptions.**

Specifically exempted from the application of this ordinance are apartment buildings containing **seven** or more units and residential developments with privately maintained streets. Further exemptions may be granted by the City Administrator or his designee should an aggrieved person file a written claim for exemption with the City Administrator's Office.

3. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.




I further certify that on January 4, 1999, the Corporate Authorities of such municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 1999-M-2, entitled
