



**An Ordinance Amending Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations,"
Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages," Section 5.08.050 "License - Application
Requirements," of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations," Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages," Section 5.08.050, "License – Application Requirements," Subsection A, Paragraph 12, of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

12. Any applicant for a new city liquor license, or any applicant for a renewal of a city liquor license is to be fingerprinted whether said applicant is an individual or a partnership. Should the applicant be a corporation, the commissioner may, within his discretion, require the following to be fingerprinted: the officers, manager or director thereof, or any stockholder or stockholders owning in the aggregate of more than five percent of the capital stock of said corporation. All such fingerprinting shall be done by the city police department. There shall be a fingerprint fee of fifty (\$50) dollars per application to be paid at time of application and non-refundable.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


I further certify that on April 19, 1999, the Corporate Authorities of such municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 1999-M-21, entitled
