AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.12 "SEWERS" OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That Chapter 13.12 "Sewers," Section 13.12.830 "Charges for Residential Users" Subsection A, Paragraph 1, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:
 - A. The residential sewer user charge shall be as follows:
 - 1. The residential sewer user charge shall be billed monthly and shall appear on the monthly utility bill prepared by the city and shall be based on the water purchased by the user from the city during the winter quarter. The following rate shall be charged for sewer service to all residential users: seven dollars and thirty-five cents demand charge per month plus two dollars and ninety-one cents per one thousand gallons of water used. The calculations of the monthly sewer user charge shall be computed annually by the city as soon as possible after the winter quarter water billings have been completed, and such monthly user charge shall apply to billings sent to customers beginning in April of the same year and ending with billings sent in March of the following year.
- 2. That Chapter 13.12 "Sewers," Section 13.12.840 "User Charges for Metered Water Consumption and Nonresidential Use," Subsection A, Paragraph 1 and 2, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:
 - A. The non-residential sewer user charge shall be as follows:
 - 1. The following rate shall be charged for sewer service to all non-residential Users of City sewers based upon metered water consumption: seven dollars and thirty-five cents demand charge per month plus two dollars and ninety-one cents per one thousand gallons of water used.
 - 2. The following rate shall be charged for sewer service to all non-residential users of City sewers where water consumption does not reflect the actual quantity of wastewater tributary to the wastewater treatment works: seven dollars and thirty-five cents per month plus two dollars and ninety-one cents per one thousand gallons of wastewater actually discharged into the sewer system
- 3. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority

of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the city of St. Charles.
