



**An Ordinance Amending Title 10, "Vehicles And Traffic"
Chapter 10.44, "Bicycle Paths,"
Section 10.44.010, "Bicycle Paths," of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic," Chapter 10.44, "Bicycle Paths," Section 10.44.010, "Bicycle Paths," of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.44.010. Bicycle Paths. The following public ways are designated as bicycle paths:

- A. The westerly 10 feet of North Third Avenue from its intersection with the entrance to the Fox River Trail/Norris Woods Nature Preserve, south to the intersection of Iroquois Avenue, then the northerly 10 feet of Iroquois Avenue west to its intersection with North Second Avenue, then the westerly 10 feet of North Second Avenue south to its intersection with North Avenue, then the northerly 10 feet of North Avenue west into Pottawatomie Park.
- B. That the Freedom Walk from its intersection with the Union Pacific Railroad Bridge south to the north edge of the Municipal Center Plaza with signage "Shared Pedestrian Walkway," then east to North 1st Avenue, then south along the westerly sidewalk on North 1st Avenue to the intersection of Illinois Avenue.
- C. The Foot Bridge spanning the Fox River as a link between the East Fox River Trail and the West Fox River Tail.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


I further certify that on August 2, 1999, the Corporate Authorities of such municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 1999-M-53, entitled
