



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5 "BUSINESS LICENSES
AND REGULATIONS," CHAPTER 5.08, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES"
SECTION 5.08.080 "LICENSE-CLASSES AND FEES"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations" Chapter 5.08 "Alcoholic Beverages" Section 5.08.080 (I) "License-Classes and Fees" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Hours. It is unlawful to sell or serve beer or wine other than between the hours of 11:00 o'clock a.m. and 11:00 p.m. of any week day except Friday and Saturday when the hours shall be from 11:00 o'clock a.m. to 11:59 p.m. and between the hours of noon and 10:00 o'clock p.m. of any Sunday, except as noted below.

3. Number of Licenses. There will be only six Class I licenses in any one year.

4. Change of Locations. b. License Number 2 is not to be removed from the location at 105 North Second Avenue in the City without the approval of the City Council and the consent of the local Liquor Commissioner and permits open air service only in the fenced in west patio as shown in the site plan attached hereto as Exhibit A and not in the east patio;

Further, License Number 2 shall be allowed to serve wine and champagne for consumption when sold on the premises in conjunction with food services between the hours of 10:00 o'clock a.m. and noon on Sunday.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.


