



ORDINANCE NO. 2000-M- 40

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 10
"VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" CHAPTER 10.58
"TOWING SERVICES" OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 10 "Vehicles and Traffic" Chapter 10.58 "Towing Services" of the St. Charles
Municipal Code be and is hereby amended as follows:

A. Section 10.58.060H paragraph 2 is amended to read as follows:

List of location of storage lot(s), zoning classifications, dimensions thereof, relationship to primary business operation, proof of ownership or signed lease agreement, valid for one year, and the type of protection at said lot(s).

B. Section 10.58.120 "Review of Applications" is hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be the duty of the Chief of Police, or his designated agent, to investigate all applications submitted. The Chief of Police may deny any application if, after due investigation, he finds that the applicant does not meet the minimum requirements set forth herein.

C. Section 10.58.130 "Number of Agencies" is added to the Code and shall read as follows:

The Chief of Police shall also determine the number of towing agencies used the Department based on calls for service, as well as ability of the rostered agencies to provide any and all services and requirements as stated in 10.58.040 of this Chapter.

D. Section 10.58.140 "Assignment" is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Chief of Police may, at his discretion, and upon consent of the City Council Government Services Committee, assign a towing service to operate in conjunction with those firms already on the towing roster, in the event that those firms are not available to respond to police or other City Departments request for service as outlined in Section 10.58.180 of this Chapter.

This towing service shall meet all the requirements set forth in this Chapter and have made application and been inspected to insure compliance.

Any firm listed on the roster, including any firm listed as “stand-by” as outlined above, shall not assign its position in this schedule to other towing concerns, nor assign any calls, without the written consent of the Chief of Police or his designated agent.

E. Section 10.58.280 “insurance” is amended to read as follows:

Each firm listed on said firm roster shall have in full force and effect during the period said firm remains on said roster, public liability, property damage and fire and theft insurance coverage. Proof of said coverage shall be a minimum eligibility requirement. The amounts of public liability and property damage shall not be less than:

Public Liability - \$500,000.00 for one person injured in one accident and \$1,000,000.00 aggregate for more than one person injured in one accident.

Property Damage - \$500,000.00 per occurrence.

Such public liability and property damage policy shall name the City as an additional insured.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.




