



ORDINANCE NO. 2000-M-44

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.12 "SEWERS"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 13.12 "Sewers," Section 13.12.830 "Charges for Residential Users"

Subsection A, Paragraph 1 and 4, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

13.12.830 Charges for Residential Users

- A. The residential sewer user charge shall be as follows:

1. **The following rate shall be charged for non-summer sewer service to all residential users of City sewers based upon metered water consumption for non-summer months: seven dollars and thirty-five cents demand charge per month plus two dollars and ninety-one cents per one thousand gallons of water used. For summer months, the residential sewer user charge shall be billed monthly and shall appear on the monthly utility bill prepared by the city and shall be based on the water purchased by the user from the city during the winter quarter. The following rate shall be charged for summer sewer service to all residential users: seven dollars and thirty-five cents demand charge per month plus two dollars and ninety-one cents per one thousand gallons of water billed during the winter quarter. The calculations of the monthly summer sewer user charge shall be computed annually by the city. For the purposes hereof the "summer months" shall be the customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after May 15 and the four succeeding monthly billing periods and "winter quarter" shall be months of January, February, and March.**

4. For new or recently constructed residential buildings or other customers which have a water meter and **an incomplete** history of water consumption during a winter quarter, the existing residential rate per thousand gallons plus the existing demand charge per month shall be applied to their metered water consumption until the completion of a winter quarter.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.




I further certify that on June 5, 2000, the Corporate Authorities of such municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 2000-M-44, entitled
