

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13.08 "ELECTRICITY"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," Section 13.08.230 "Rate 1 – Residential – Rates, Charges and Service Requirements." Subsection B, Paragraph 1 and 2, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

13.08.230 Rate 1 - Residential - Rates, Charges and Service Requirements.

B. Charges for this rate shall be as follows:

1. Monthly Customer Charge. The net monthly customer charge shall be four dollars and **twenty-eight cents (\$4.28)** per meter.
2. Energy Charge. The net energy charge shall be as follows:

Summer Months

	Kilowatt-hours
\$.081 per kilowatt-hour for the first	1000
\$.097 per kilowatt-hour all over	1000

Non-summer Months

	Kilowatt-hours
\$.059 per kilowatt-hour for the first	500
\$.033 per kilowatt-hour for all over	500

For the purposes hereof the "summer months" shall be the customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.

2. That Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," Section 13.08.240 "Rate 3 – Small General Service – Rates, Charges, and Service Requirements." Subsection B, Paragraph 1 and 2, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

13.08.240 Rate 3 – Small General Service – Rates, Charges, and Service Requirements.

B. Charges for this rate shall be as follows:

1. Monthly Customer Charge. The net monthly customer charge shall be seven dollars **and fifty cents (\$7.50)** per meter.
2. Energy Charge. The net energy charge shall be as follows:
\$.090 per kilowatt-hour Summer Months
\$.063 per kilowatt-hour Non-Summer Months

For purposes hereof, the "summer months" shall be the customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.

3. That Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," Section 13.08.260 "Rate 5 – General service – Rates, Charges, and Service Requirements," Subsection B, Paragraph 1, 2, and 3, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

13.08.260 Rate 5 - General service - Rates, Charges, and Service Requirements.

B. Charges for this rate shall be as follows:

1. Monthly Customer Charge. The net monthly customer charge shall be **twenty-six** dollars **and seventy-eight cents (\$26.78)** per meter.
2. Demand Charge. The net demand charge shall be as follows:
\$12.59 per kilowatt Summer Months
\$ 9.10 per kilowatt Non-summer Months

For the purposes hereof the "summer months" shall be the customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.

3. Energy Charge. The energy charge shall be as follows:
\$.029 per kilowatt-hour for all kilowatt-hours

4. That Chapter 13.08 "Electricity," Section 13.08.275 "Rate 7 – Large General Service – Rates, , " Subsection B, Paragraph 1, 2, and 3, of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

13.08.275 Rate 7 - Large General Service - Rates, Charges and Service Requirements.

B. Charges for this rate shall be as follows:

1. Monthly Customer Charge. The net monthly customer charge shall be one hundred **seven dollars and ten cents (\$107.10)** per meter.

2. Demand Charge. The net demand charge shall be as follows:
\$12.59 per kilowatt Summer Months
\$ 9.10 per kilowatt Non-Summer Months

For the purposes hereof the "summer months" shall be the customer's first monthly billing period with an ending meter reading date on or after June 15 and the three succeeding monthly billing periods.


3. Energy Charge. The net energy charge shall be as follows:
\$.033 per kilowatt-hour On-Peak
\$.023 per kilowatt-hour Off-Peak

5. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.




