ORDINANCE NO. 2001-M- 59

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5, "BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS," CHAPTER 5.08, "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES," SECTION 5.08.080, "LICENSE - CLASSES AND FEES," OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations," Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages," Section 5.08.080, "License - Classes and Fees," of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by creating a subclass license Class C1 that reads as follows:

1. Class C1 license shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors on the premises of 105 East Main Street for consumption on the premises from one permanent location in the vestibule, one service bar in the balcony and up to two other service bars as dictated by the event; provided, however, that unless employed by the licensee, no person under the age of 21 years shall be present on the premises during the exhibition of motion pictures for commercial profit while alcohol is being served.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.
