



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5
"BUSINESS LICENSE AND REGULATIONS" CHAPTER 5.08
"ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" SECTION 5.08.080 "LICENSE-CLASSES AND FEES"
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,
KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations" Chapter 5.08 "Alcoholic Beverages" Section 5.08.080 (F) "License-Classes and Fees" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefor:

Class F Licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors on the premises of an club for consumption on the premises; provided, that such club shall have been in existence for at least six months prior to the filing of an application for a license under this chapter and shall have maintained club rooms for such period of time immediately preceding the filing of its application. Further, there is a Class F license created for the sale of beer and wine only located at 3491 Swenson Avenue. Said license is only in effect on the following days and times: Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays and Sundays from 6:00 o'clock p.m. to 11:00 o'clock p.m. As a further condition of the license at 3491 Swenson Avenue, no person under the age of 21 years of age shall be allowed on the premises unless accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. The annual license fee for class F licenses shall be \$1,000.00.


2. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.


