



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 2
"ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL" CHAPTER 2.30
"FIRE DEPARTMENT" SECTIONS 2.30.010 "CREATED - COMPOSITION"
AND SECTION 2.30.030 "FULL-TIME FIREMEN - APPOINTMENT AND
PROMOTION" OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST.
CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 2" Administration and Personnel" Chapter 2.30 "Fire Department"
Section 2.30.10 "Created - Composition" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be
amended to read as follows:

There is created a fire department, an executive department of the city. The Fire Department shall consist of the fire chief, assistant chiefs and/or equivalent rank, captains, lieutenants, firefighters, and such additional members that may be provided for, from time to time, by the mayor and city council. Other members of the Fire Department are to be known as paid-on-call firefighters. Within this group a yearly election shall be held to elect a president, secretary, treasurer, and such other members as may be provided for from time to time. All appointed members of the Fire Department, including the Fire Chief, are to be considered to be employees of the city.

2. That Title 2 "Administration and Personnel" Chapter 2.30 "Police Department"
Section 2.30.30 "Full-time firemen - "Appointment and Promotion" of the St.
Charles Municipal Code, be amended as follows:

- A. Except hereinafter set forth, all appointments and promotions to the fire department shall be made by the board of fire and police commissioners as provided for by law.

- B. The fire chief shall be appointed by the mayor for the term of one year or until his or her successor is appointed, commencing May 1 of each year, with such appointment to be confirmed by the city council.
 - C. The fire chief is authorized to appoint, suspend or discharge the two assistant fire chiefs subject to the advice and consent of the city administrator. In the event the fire chief discharges an assistant chief, said officer shall revert to his or her permanent rank, if any, in the fire department as established under statute or city ordinance. An assistant fire chief may be appointed from any full-time officer, and while such officer shall hold the position of assistant fire chief, his position as a permanent officer within the department shall remain open.
 - D. Any full-time member of the fire department appointed as fire chief or assistant fire chief shall be classified during his or her term in such position as on furlough from the fire department at the rank to which he or she is entitled under the board of fire and police commission at the beginning of his or her term of office, he or she shall be returned to active duty as a full-time member at his or her rank and seniority and shall thereafter be entitled to all benefits and emoluments of such prior rank with regard with to whether a vacancy exists in such rank..
 - E. This ordinance does not affect those who hold the position of Assistant Fire Chief on the date of its adoption.
3. That after adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.


