ORDINANCE NO. 2003-M - 96

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5  
"BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS" CHAPTER 5.08  
"ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" SECTION 5.08.080(A) "LICENSE-CLASSES  
AND FEES" OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES,  
KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations" Chapter 5.08 "Alcoholic Beverages" Section 5.08.080 (A) "License-Classes and Fees" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Class A Licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors in packages and not for consumption on the premises. Curb service or sale is prohibited. If the Class A licensee is located in the same building as a food store or drug store, or in an adjoining building and if there is access from the food store or drug store, it shall be through a solid permanent dividing wall where the dividing wall runs from the floor to a minimum of 72 inches in height. This entrance shall include means of securing and locking off the entrance after hours. The annual license fee for such license shall be \$1,600.00.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.



3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.




I further certify that on December 1, 2003, the Corporate Authorities of such municipality passed and approved Ordinance No. 2003-M-96, entitled
