

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-M - 51

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9 "PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS AND WELFARE" CHAPTER 9.52 "CURFEW" SECTION 9.52.010 "CURFEW" OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Title 9 "Public Peace, Morals and Welfare" Chapter 9.52 "Curfew" Section 9.52.010 "Curfew" of the St. Charles Municipal Code be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

It is unlawful for a person less than 17 years of age to be present at or upon any building, place, street or highway at the following described times unless accompanied and supervised by a parent, legal guardian or other responsible companion of at least 18 years of age who is approved by a parent or legal guardian:

- A. Between 12:01 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturdays;
- B. Between 12:01 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Sundays;
- C. Between 11:00 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday, inclusive, and 6:00 a.m. on the following day.

The following activities are exempted from the provisions of this ordinance:

If the person less than 17 years of age is (a) engaged in employment or occupation upon which the laws of the State of Illinois authorizes a person less than 17 years of age to perform; (b) at an official civic, school-related or religious activity; (c) engaged in organized political protest or political activity; (d) any other core First Amendment activity.

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office and approval in the manner provided by law.
