Ordinance No. 2006-M- 17

**An Ordinance Amending Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic,"
Chapter 10.40.040, "No-Parking places designated – Prohibited Parking,"
of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 10, "Vehicles and Traffic," Chapter 10.40.040, "No-Parking places designated – Prohibited Parking", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by adding the following therefor:

10.40.040

T. It is unlawful for any person to cause, allow, or permit a vehicle to stop for any purpose or length of time other than the period of time necessary for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pick up and loading of materials in any place designated by ordinance by the Mayor and City Council as a freight loading zone and marked as such during the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and in no case shall such vehicle stop for a period of time in excess of thirty (30) minutes, or for loading and unloading of passengers in any place designated by ordinance by the Mayor and City Council as a ~~freight loading zone~~ **drop off zone** and marked as such, or in any of the following designated places:

1. (No Changes)

2. ~~Loading Zone. Drop Off Zone.~~ **Any place designated by the Mayor and City Council for the loading and unloading of passengers. In no case shall such vehicle stop for a period time in excess of fifteen (15) minutes or left unattended in the following places:**

a. No changes

b. No changes

c. Directly in front of the entrance to any theater at any time the theater is open, or restaurant, provided the space shall not exceed seventy-five (75) feet.

d. On the east side of North Fourth Street from the driveway directly to the south of 18 North Fourth Street, extending northerly 42 feet to a point adjacent to the sidewalk on the right-of-way extending from the main entrance of 18 North Fourth Street.


2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


