



**Ordinance No. 2006-M- 24**

**An Ordinance Amending Title 2, "Administration And Personnel,"  
Chapter 2.10, "Appointive Officers,"  
of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE  
AND DU PAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 2 "Administration and Personnel," Chapter 2.10 "Appointive Officers,"  
Section 2.10.125 "City Administrator – Responsibilities" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is  
hereby amended by deleting the same and substituting the following therefore:

**2.10.125 City Administrator – Responsibilities**


The position of City Administrator is hereby created. The City Administrator shall be chosen on the basis of executive and administrative qualifications with special reference to actual experience in, and knowledge of, accepted practices with respect to the duties of his or her employment as set forth herein and in the job description as established from time to time by the Mayor and City Council. At the time of such appointment, the City Administrator need not be a resident of the City, but shall reside within the city limits within *twelve (12)* months of appointment.


2. That after the adoption and approval hereof the Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
