**ORDINANCE NO. 2006-M- 67**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5 "BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS", CHAPTER 5.08 "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES", SECTION 5.08.080 (A), "LICENSE-CLASSES AND FEES; CLASS A – PACKAGED ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR LICENSES" OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Title 5, "Business Licenses and Regulations", Chapter 5.08, "Alcoholic Beverages", Section 5.08.080 (A), "License-Classes and Fees; Class A – Packaged Alcoholic Liquor Licenses" of the St. Charles Municipal Code, is hereby amended by deleting the introductory paragraph contained therein in its entirety and in lieu thereof the following language shall be substituted:

**"Class A - Packaged Alcoholic Liquor Licenses**

A. Class A licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors in original packages only and not for consumption on the premises. Class A licensed alcoholic liquor sales shall be limited to the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, and 12:00 noon to 10:00 p.m. on Sunday except where December 24 or December 31 occurs on a Sunday, then Class A licensed alcoholic liquor sales shall be limited to the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Unless otherwise defined, the annual license fee for all Class A licenses shall be One Thousand Six Hundred (\$1,600) dollars. Class A licenses shall be additionally divided into the following sub-classes:"...

2. That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the Council, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the passage and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
