ORDINANCE NO. 2007-M-27

**CITY OF ST. CHARLES, ILLINOIS**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5 (BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 5.08 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES), SECTION 5.08.080 (LICENSE-CLASSES AND FEES), OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

**BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE:** That Title 5, Chapter 5.08, Section 5.08.080 of the St. Charles Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting Paragraph A-3 in its entirety, and inserting the following language in lieu thereof:

“A-3. Class A-3 licenses shall authorize the retail sale of alcoholic liquors both on the premises and off the premises; off premise sales to be in original packages only. Special closing hours for Class A-3 original package sales only shall be between the hours of 12:59 a.m. to 7 a.m. of any weekday and between the hours of 12:59 a.m. and noon of any Sunday. Such special closing hours shall terminate on April 30, 2009, and are not renewable. Class A-3 licenses shall meet the requirements of Section 5.08.010 (H-1 and H-2), as set forth above. Live entertainment and supplemental late hours shall not be permitted. There shall be one Class A-3 licenses issued. No additional Class A-3 licenses shall be issued. The fee for a Class A-3 license shall be Two Thousand (\$2,000) dollars per year.”

**SECTION TWO:** That after the adoption and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall: 1. be printed or published in a book or pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the City Council; or 2. within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in, and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.



**SECTION FOUR:** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption and publication.


