


ORDINANCE NO. 2007-M-31

PRESENTED AND PASSED BY THE
CITY COUNCIL ON May 7, 2007

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.10
“APPOINTIVE OFFICERS”
OF THE ST. CHARLES MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.10 of the St. Charles Municipal Code establishes the staff officer positions described as Director of Community Development and Director of Economic Development, among others; and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it is in the best interest of the City to amend the provisions of Chapter 2.10 “Appointive Officers” of the St. Charles Municipal Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Section 2.10.070, “Staff Officers – Positions Designated” of Chapter 2.10, “Appointive Officers” of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting paragraph “g” of said Section 2.10.070 in its entirety.

SECTION 2: That Section 2.10.220, “Director of Community Development -- responsibilities”, of Chapter 2.10, “Appointive Officers” of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting said Section 2.10.220 in its entirety and by substituting the following therefor:

“2.10.220 Director of Community Development - Responsibilities.

The Director of Community Development shall conduct research and propose plans, policies and ordinances relative to the City’s growth, development, and housing supply, administer the Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances, building codes, and property maintenance codes in cooperation with other City departments, promote business retention, growth and expansion, and maintain data pertaining to economic development, population demographics, and projected growth. The Director of Community Development shall also assist the

Director of Public Works in planning for transportation, utilities, and other infrastructure.”

SECTION 3: That Section 2.10.225, “Director of Economic Development -- responsibilities”, of Chapter 2.10, “Appointive Officers” of the St. Charles Municipal Code, be and is hereby amended by deleting said Section 2.10.225 in its entirety.


SECTION 4: That after the adoption and approval hereof this Ordinance shall be (i) printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the City Council; or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the adoption and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.
