

Ordinance No. 2009-M-39**

An Ordinance Amending Title 5, “Business Licenses and Regulations,” Chapter 5.08 “Alcoholic Beverages,” Section 5.08.080 “License – Classes and Fees” and Section 5.08.090 “License – Number to be Issued” of the St. Charles Municipal Code

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: That Title 5, “Business Licenses and Regulations”, Chapter 5.08, “Alcoholic Beverages”, Section 5.08.080, “License – Classes and Fees”, of the St. Charles Municipal Code, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Class B-6 license as follows:

...“B-6. Notwithstanding any general Class B license provisions to the contrary, Class B-6 licenses shall authorize the retail sale of beer and wine for consumption on the premises only. The premises primary purpose shall be counter service of food. Beer and wine shall be served only by counter service and only in conjunction with the service of food. The fee for a Class B-6 license shall be one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200).”


SECTION TWO: That Title 5, “Business Licenses and Regulations”, Chapter 5.08, “Alcoholic Beverages”, Section 5.08.090, “License – Number to be Issued”, of the St. Charles Municipal Code, is hereby deleted in its entirety, and in lieu thereof the following language shall be substituted:

“5.08.090 License – Number to be Issued.
There shall be issued no more than a maximum of twenty Class A, forty-seven Class B, nine Class C and eight Class D licenses.”


SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.


