**Ordinance No. 2009-M-6**

**An Ordinance Amending Title 12, "Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places", Adding A New Chapter 12.50, "Special Events" of the St. Charles Municipal Code**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ST. CHARLES, KANE AND DUPAGE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One: That Title 12, "Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places", of the St. Charles Municipal Code, is hereby amended by changing the title of said Title 12 to read as follows:

"Streets, Sidewalks, Public Places and Special Events"

Section Two: That Title 12, "Streets, Sidewalks, Public Places and Special Events", of the St. Charles Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Chapter 12.50, "Special Events", as follows:

"Chapter 12.50  
SPECIAL EVENTS

Sections:

- 12.50.010 Special Events Policy Established
- 12.50.020 Special Events – Approval Required, Compliance with Policy
- 12.50.030 Violation – Penalty

12.50.010 Special Events Policy Established.

The corporate authorities shall adopt by ordinance, and may amend from time to time, a Special Events Policy. The Special Events Policy shall contain such terms, conditions and restrictions as the corporate authorities deem appropriate governing the approval and conduct of Special Events. The Special Events Policy, as amended from time to time, is expressly incorporated in this Section 12.50.010 by reference, as if set out in full. Copies of the Special Events Policy shall be kept on file in the office of Building and Code Enforcement.

12.50.020 Special Events – Approval Required, Compliance with Policy.

It is unlawful for any person to conduct a Special Event within the corporate limits of the City, unless approval therefore has first been

obtained in accordance with and as provided for in the Special Events Policy. It is further unlawful for any person to conduct a Special Event in violation of any provision of the Special Events Policy.

12.50.030 Violation – Penalty.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Chapter shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues.”


Section Three: That, after the passage and approval hereof, this Ordinance shall (i) be printed or published in book or pamphlet form, published by the authority of the City Council of the City of St. Charles, or (ii) within thirty (30) days after the passage and approval hereof, be published in a newspaper published in and with a general circulation within the City of St. Charles.


Section Four: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days from and after its passage by a vote of the majority of the corporate authorities now holding office, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
